In February 2018, Boko Harm abducted 110 girls from their school in Dapchi, Nigeria. One of these girls was called Leah. In March 2018, following negotiations by the government, the girls were put into vehicles to go home. However, Leah wasn't among them. She wasn't released because she refused to renounce her faith in exchange for her freedom. On **Wednesday 18th July**, to mark 150 days since her abduction, Christians around the world are coming together in 24 hours of prayer and action.

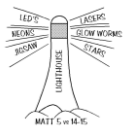
