Management Accounts: Following a review of the Q3 Management Accounts (Jan – Sept 2017) by the Finance Committee, the Elders would like to provide an update on the financial situation. The budget for this period estimated a deficit of approximately £6,000. However, excluding income received from legacies, the deficit for this period is actually approximately £23,000. Costs are slightly lower than expected, and in this instance, the increased deficit has been partly offset by receipt of legacies; however these figures clearly demonstrate that income from giving is lower than the budget estimates, and Elders wanted members and regular worshippers to be aware of this overall situation which is rather disappointing.
